## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

### OVERVIEW

The *SleepLine* literature reference service offers you easy, economical and rapid access to the biomedical journal literature most frequently used by sleep disorders specialists and researchers.

The literature references are stored on CD-ROM (Compact Disc, Read-Only Memory) optical data discs. Computer search software designed for Microsoft® Windows™ and the Apple® Macintosh® lets you search these discs easily and quickly.

Each data disc contains over a third of a million journal article references, selected from the National Library of Medicine's (NLM) MEDLINE® database.

### THE *SleepLine* DATABASE

The *SleepLine* database includes two CD-ROM disc volumes:

**Volume I** contains an archive (updated annually) of all indexed references from approximately 120 sleep-related journals, and includes material indexed by the NLM during the most recent ten prior years. Additional references from all other MEDLINE journals are included based upon their topical relevance to sleep disorders and related topics, for a total of over 415,000 references.

**Volume II** (for optional quarterly or monthly updates) contains all MEDLINE references indexed by the NLM during the current year.

This combination assures you of comprehensive coverage of the current literature, combined with access to the important, recent sleep disorders literature.

In addition to the journals covered in entirety (listed on the other side), Volume I includes references to

articles dealing with a variety of topics, including:

**Basic sleep disorders**

**Circadian physiology**

**Enuresis & therapy**

**Narcolepsy**

**Respiratory physiology**

**Stress disorders**

Volume I is updated every calendar year, to incorporate new indexing and publishing errata. Volume II is updated and cumulated quarterly or monthly, providing you with convenient searching access to the most recently published materials.

### SEARCHING SOFTWARE

You search the *SleepLine* database using the *Knowledge Finder*® search system. With *Knowledge Finder*, searching the database can be as simple as typing a sentence that describes what you're looking for.

*Knowledge Finder* uses state-of-the-art retrieval techniques to judge which references are likely to be most relevant to what you're asking for. And the references are presented in order of their likely relevance, saving you time in the searching process.

The MeSH® subject heading thesaurus helps you identify the correct terminology for searching the database.

Article citations (most of which include informative abstracts) are

shown rapidly and clearly on the computer screen.

With *Knowledge Finder*, you don't have to take the time to become an expert searcher. In fact, most users discover that they're searching successfully within a few minutes of their first use of *Knowledge Finder*.

### COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

To use *SleepLine* with *Knowledge Finder*, you'll need a PC (model 80386 or later) with Microsoft Windows, or an Apple Macintosh, a compatible CD-ROM player, a floppy disk drive, a hard disk drive, and a printer. You can also access the *SleepLine* database in many network environments, using our *Knowledge Server*® software. This lets multiple PC and Macintosh users access a single CD-ROM database concurrently.
